



31st Jan New Moon in Aquarius

For all you early birds

Jupiter is setting in the western sky while Mars and Saturn are visible in the east. And you may be lucky to see Venus pop up in the eastern horizon as the Morning Star. But I think she will be lost in the dazzle of the rising Sun. Let the moon be your guide when she will be close to Mars on the 23rd and 24th, then close to Saturn on the 26th. She will be with Venus on the horizon on the 29th and 30th.
