Aries 21 March – 19 April



What are you going to decide?




Aquarius 20 Jan – 18 Feb

The movement of the planets herald time when we feel mood changes, times we are galvanized to take action, and others times when we lack energy. What's that in the sky? April 2014

To be amazed by the heavens, first get your bearings and note that the sun rises in the east, sets in the west and the warmest side of the house is north. ☺

For all you night owls

Jupiter is the wonderful bright star you will see each evening. He is half way down to the western horizon and disappears into the horizon by midnight. Turn around to see Mars climbing up in the east and rising high by midnight, while Saturn is low on the eastern horizon. Let the Moon be your guide when she is close to Jupiter on the 6th and 7th. Then close to reddish Mars on the 14th and finally close to creamy Saturn on the 17th April.

Further east and a little lower from Jupiter is Pollux and near him is Castor. These are the two brother twins of Gemini. One was mortal the other was immortal and their love was so great that when mortal Castor was killed, Pollux begged to die with him. Zeus decreed that they would stay together in the heavens forever. The bright star higher in the sky is Regulus, the magnificent heart of Leo the lion. The other bright star even higher and further west is Sirius, the Dog Star and the Southern Cross is high in the southern sky and rolling to its side during the month.

For all you early birds

The beautiful Venus is shining in the east as the morning star. The Moon will be close to her on the 26th April. Mars is falling into the western horizon with Saturn starting his tumble down from the heights. Early in the month Mercury may make an appearance very low on the eastern horizon just before the sun rises. His visibility depends on an unobstructed view away from city lights.

This is the best time of the night to see the Scorpion. He is further to the east than Saturn and predominant overhead. Look for the sweeping curve of his tail with the reddish colored star Antares is in his head. Over the month he moves slowly over to the west. He is almost worth a very early morning walk! Turn around to see the Southern Cross high in the southern sky lying on its side and rolling upright over the month.

Let yourself be awed!

29 th April	New Moon in Taurus with Annular Solar Eclipse visible here in Australia	Rest time. Cultivate an attitude of abundance for all.
