

**News from the Stars**

- 5<sup>th</sup> Oct Mercury goes retrograde in Scorpio
- 8<sup>th</sup> Oct **Full Moon** in Aries with **total Eclipse** visible here in Australia at Moon rise
- 11<sup>th</sup> Oct Mercury enters Libra
- 23<sup>rd</sup> Oct Sun enters Scorpio
- 24<sup>th</sup> Oct **New Moon** in Scorpio with Partial Solar Eclipse not visible here
- 24<sup>th</sup> Oct Venus enters Scorpio
- 26<sup>th</sup> Oct Mercury turns direct in Libra
- 26<sup>th</sup> Oct Mars enters Capricorn



The movement of the planets herald time when we feel mood changes, times we are galvanized to take action, and others times when we lack energy. There are shifts in feelings and energy levels at all New and Full Moons, when planets move into signs, or when there are connections (aspects) between planets, or when they turn retrograde or move direct again.

**What's that in the sky this month?**

To be amazed by the heavens, first get you bearings and note that the sun rises in the east, sets in the west and the warmest side of the house is north. ☺

**For all you night owls out for an after dinner stroll**

Early in the month you can see Saturn low on the horizon in the west, but he and the Sun are slowly become closer so that he disappears into the glare and we lose sight of him for a few months. Mars is high in the west and is easily visible if you look for a reddish twinkle. He's not far from the Scorpion who is diving down head first into the west.

Let the Moon be your guide when she is close to Saturn on the 25<sup>th</sup> Oct and close to Mars on the 28<sup>th</sup>. Turn around to the south and look for the Sothern Cross lying on its side.

**For all you early birds up before breakfast**

Lots of star action is happening but you have to get up early to see it. Jupiter bright in the east and a beautiful sight will be the Moon with Jupiter on the 18<sup>th</sup> Oct.

Look further along the ecliptic (path of the Sun) and see Castor and Pollux the twin stars of Gemini. Keep looking along the ecliptic to see reddish colored Aldebaran, the eye of the Bull, with the Pleiades star cluster slightly lower down. They are also known as the Seven Sisters, but there are more than seven there. How many can you count?

**Halloween** is on 31<sup>st</sup> October. This is said to have originated from the ancient Celtic harvest festival known as Samhain. Halloween is also known as All Hallows' Eve among the Christian community. It is the time that the border between this world and the "other" world narrows, and the dead are honored.
