

## Super Moons!

On September 28<sup>th</sup> we will have a Super Moon with a Lunar Eclipse. We will not see the Lunare Eclipse here in Australia but we will see the Super Moon.

What is a Super Moon?..... I thought you'd never ask. ☺

To start with, I bet you thought that the Moon travelled in a perfect circle. It doesn't.

Instead it moves in an oval shape. So sometimes it's further away and sometimes it's close. And when it's a Full Moon at the time of its closest approach we see it, especially on the horizon, as a little bigger. And it also causes big big big tides!

There are two or three Super Moons each year and a Super Moon can also be a New Moon but as we don't see it; it's not so interesting. But it still causes big big tides!

Go outside to see the big Moon and say hello from ME. I will also say hello from you. ☺

6<sup>th</sup> Sep Venus turns direct

13<sup>th</sup> Sep **New Moon** in Virgo with Partial Solar Eclipse not visible in Australia

17<sup>th</sup> Sep Jupiter opposite Neptune

18<sup>th</sup> Sep Mercury turns retrograde

18<sup>th</sup> Sep Saturn enters Sagittarius

23<sup>rd</sup> Sep Sun enters Libra and it's the Spring Equinox

25<sup>th</sup> Sep Pluto turns direct

25<sup>th</sup> Sep Mars enters Virgo

26<sup>th</sup> Sep Mars square Saturn

28<sup>th</sup> Sep **Full Moon** in Aries with Super Moon and a Lunar Total Eclipse not visible in Australia

The movement of the planets herald time when we feel mood changes, times we are galvanized to take action, and others times when we lack energy. There are shifts in feelings and energy levels at all New and Full Moons, when planets move into signs, or when there are connections (aspects) between planets, or when they turn retrograde or move direct again.

## What's that in the sky?

To be amazed by the heavens, first get your bearings and note that the sun rises in the east, sets in the west and the warmest side of the house is north. ☺ The darkest night is with the New Moon on the 13<sup>th</sup> Sep and the brightest night is at the Full Moon on the 28<sup>th</sup> Sep.

### For all you night owls

In the first half of this month, Mercury is visible just after sunset in the west as he follows the Sun below the horizon, then he disappears into the sun's glare. It only takes half an hour of watching (maybe wait till warmer summertime!) to spot that he is the one moving while all the other stars stay still. Let the Moon be your guide when she is close to him on the 15<sup>th</sup> September.

The Moon will then visit Saturn high in the west on the 19<sup>th</sup> Sep. He is the creamy colored one "with bumps" when you use a good pair of binoculars. I will never forget the first time I used a hand held telescope and saw the rings. I was so amazed that I thought somebody had stuck a picture on the end of the telescope!!

The Scorpion is higher than Saturn and is diving head first downwards as if chasing Saturn. Look to the South to see the Southern Cross on its side under the pointer Stars.

### **For all you early birds**

The early morning skies show Venus and Mars close together rising in the east just before the Sun comes up but be quick for the sun will soon obscure them from view. The Goddess Venus is now the Morning star and is having a golly good time with Mr. Testosterone Mars.

One can only imagine what stories and meanings the ancients would have made of their conjunction. The slender crescent Moon joins them on the 11<sup>th</sup> September for a beautiful morning sight. Yes; I will be hoping for clear skies and I will be well rugged up as I go out for 6am walk with the stars.

Further to the North are the Pleiades, also known as the Seven Sisters, in the enduring heart of Taurus the Bull and his steady patient eye is the bright star Aldebaran. Above them is the hunter Orion but here in the Southern Hemisphere we know his sword belt as the Saucepan. Greek myth says that Orion chased the sisters across the night sky and would you believe it, indigenous aboriginal stories saw this constellation as men chasing sisters across the night sky. Was there contact between the ancient Greeks and the indigenous Australian people? Or do these stories go back to the beginning of time? I am going to smile at the wonder of our history, and the beauty of the world. Then to remind myself of my roots, I will turn around to see the Southern Cross, our home constellation, lying on its side low in the southern skies.

**Let yourself be awed!**
