



What's That in the Sky this October?

To be amazed by the heavens, first get your bearings and note that the sun rises in the east, sets in the west and the warmest side of the house is north. ☺

The darkest night is with the New Moon on the 13th Oct and the brightest night is the Full Moon on the 27th Oct.

For all you night owls

Creamy colored Saturn is low in the west and while difficult to spot, the Moon will be close to him on the 16th Oct. By the end of the month Saturn will nearly gone into the glare of the setting sun. No other planets are visible, but it's party time first thing in the mornings! The Sun is in the zodiac sign Scorpio, which means the Sun is travelling with the Scorpion and hence it is impossible to see the great stinger due to the Sun brightness. The Southern Cross is so low it may be hidden by hills or buildings.

Mars until he is just below Venus, so in essence he gets rid of the opposition and wins the girl in this month's star story. The crescent Moon joins them on the 9th and 10th Oct.

Look northwards to see Orion's sword belt, known here as the Saucepan, above the Pleiades (The Seven Sisters), a beautiful star cluster easy to spot.
